## **Directions to Tri-State Camp**

From Tallahassee: Go west on Interstate 10 to DeFuniak Springs, FL (EXIT-85) turn right off the interstate onto Hwy 331 north and proceed to HWY 90, turn left onto HWY 90 west and go approximately 4 miles to First Christian Church of DeFuniak Springs, turn right after the Church onto Peacock Road and continue to the next right onto Christian Camp Road, and continue thru the camp gates to the main build-

From Pensacola: Go east on Interstate 10 to Mossy Head, (Exit 70) and turn left onto HWY 85, and proceed to Hwy 90, turn right onto HWY 90 and continue 10 miles to First Christian Church of DeFuniak Springs, turn left at the Church onto Peacock Road, continue on Peacock and turn right onto Christian Camp Road thru the camp gates to the main building.
