The Facilities of the camp & retreat center include a main building with a capacity of 130. This building also has a modern kitchen and flagstone fireplace. There are 6 dorms that sleep 16 people each with showers and restrooms. A staff building that has an office/conference room and 7 motel-type rooms. This building also has 2 restrooms with showers to be used by the RV and tent camping area. An Olympic sized swimming pool, softball field, basketball court, fitness course, sand volleyball court, zip line and playground are used for recreation. There are 4 picnic shelters with tables and benches that can also be used for classes. Beautiful wetlands border the large horseshoe shaped nature trail and prayer walk. All buildings have central heat and air and may be used year around.

- Beginning the overhaul of the staff apt building. Carpet cleaning, paint, etc



• September 26 - Tri-State Christian Camp - Out with the old sign, in with the new! Stay tuned, finished sign coming Friday!!














• September 27 - Took a few hours of R&R today at the beach! I wore my special hat in honor of Steve Bornemann at Lake Aurora Christian Camp.






• October 12 - Tri-State Christian Camp


















October 19 - Tri-State Christian Camp More progress today on our Dansby Country Store. Started the framing for the front deck and the serving window area!








- The rest of the outside plywood went on today and half of the handrail and bench on the front porch. Progress!
